We began our partnership with the South Gloucestershire Disability Equalities Network. In the next year will be working to ensure that disabled people can raise awareness of the things that matter to them.



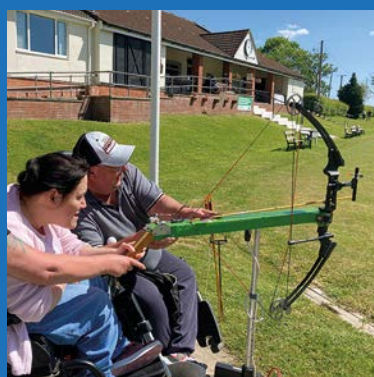
Securing our Future
